they are large and use extended wings that make it tricky to navigate in tight spaces. Please be patient as our snowplow operates at a slower speed when pushing snow or spreading sand and remember that the safest place on the road in a storm is behind the snowplow.

Hours of operation: Saturday 10am to 3pm Sunday 12pm to 4pm


Additional hours from May 15-Sept 15: Wednesday 12pm to 5pm Monday of a long weekend 12pm to 4pm
